A total of 718 libraries from 13 countries are participating in Portico:

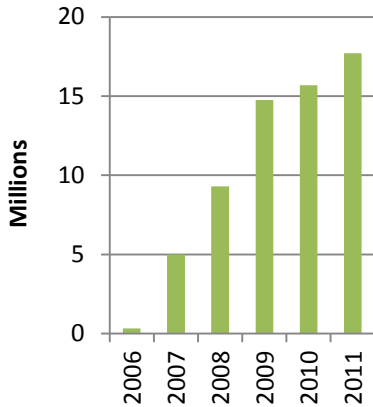

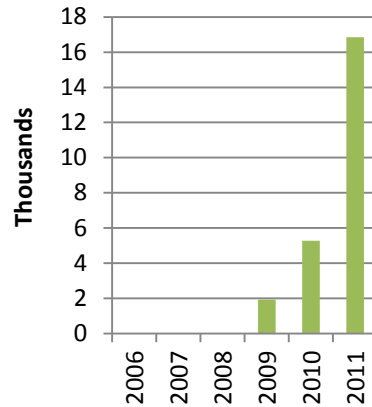
Content Ingest Activity

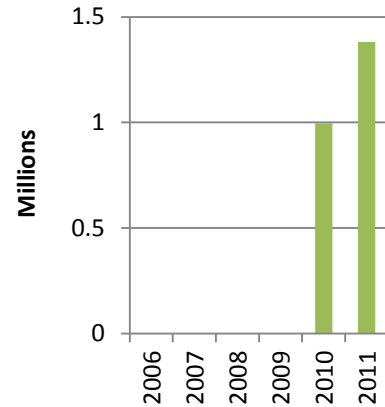
E-Journal Preservation

Trigger Events

Portico experienced two trigger events this year. E-Journal Service participants, regardless of whether your institution previously subscribed, now have access to *Annals of Clinical Psychology*, a title no longer accessible from Taylor & Francis's online offering, and *Journal of Pharmacy Teaching*, formerly published by Informa Healthcare.

These two titles bring the total number of triggered titles to six:

Post-Cancellation Access Activity

The amount of content available for use at participating institutions through post-cancellation access claims has increased significantly since the first claim in 2009. Currently, Portico is providing 145 institutions with access to more than 575,000 articles and 300 books.

Publisher Changes

As you work to manage your collections, there are some publisher changes you should be aware of:

- **Ammons Scientific** has discontinued its participation in Portico. Content from its two journals—*Psychological Reports* and *Perceptual and Motor Skills*—received by Portico prior to its termination will continue to be preserved in the Archive. - **Beech Tree Press closed its doors at the end of 2011**. Portico will ensure the long-term preservation of its three journals (*Impact Assessment and Project Appraisal*, *Research Evaluation*, and *Science and Public Policy*). Content for these journals published through year-end 2011 will be included in the Archive; we hope to work with the new publishers of these journals to preserve future content.
- **Berkeley Electronic (BE) Press**, a Portico participant, has sold its subscription-based journal business to De Gruyter. Portico will continue to preserve the 65 titles previously published by BE Press. This content will include content supplied by BE Press through summer 2011.
- **Indiana University Mathematics Journal** has discontinued its participation in Portico. Content from the journal published through year-end 2011 will continue to be preserved in the Archive.
